E. Accommodations

10. Dormitory

We try to offer all exchange students a room in one of our on-campus International Residence Halls. However, in the rare case when there are no open rooms to accommodate students, they may have to reside in another international students' dormitory in the Tokyo area or find a private apartment on their own.

11. Accommodation fee(Campus Dormitory) SINGLE ROOM ONLY

International Residence Hall No.1 ¥22,000 per month (Single room)

International Residence Hall No.2 ¥21,000 per month (Single room)

International Residence Hall No.3 ¥46,000 per month (Single room) plus key money (¥30,000)

* Students who would like to live with someone need to find private apartments on their own.

12. Available period for accommodation (Campus Dormitory)

Spring entry: From April 1st to the middle of July or the end of February.

Fall entry: From late September to the end of February or the middle of July.

F. Language & Visa Requirements

14. Language requirements

Sufficient language proficiency to follow lectures at TUFS is required.

Such as:

English: TOEFL - iBT71(PBT530, CBT197), IELTS - 6.0, Cambridge CAE - Grade C, and Cambridge CPE - Grade C

*Other English proficiency test is also acceptable as long as the score is equivalent to the scores above.

Japanese: Level N2 (Level N1 preferred) of Japanese Language Proficiency Test

15. Visa requirements

Student Visa

Students need to send required documents when they apply for our exchange program. Detailed information is instructed in the application web-site.

G. Insurance & Health Care Services

17. National Health Insurance

Exchange Students need to join the National Health Insurance Program. With this insurance, you will pay only 30% of the total medical expenses.

16. University insurance*

Exchange students must join in the University insurance for study abroad after coming to Japan although they have already joined in other insurance in their countries.

It covers Personal liability, Death, residual disability and Rescuer expenses.

18. Health Care Services Center and Student Counseling Consult Service on campus

Health Care Services Center on campus and Student Counseling Consult Service are available for exchange students.

*Prospective students with special needs (such as physical disabilities, medical concerns, prescription medication, mental well-being, etc.) are asked to inform the Exchange Student Division of their needs at the same time as they submit their ISEP application, so that we may be best able to accommodate them.
